ORDER

The Public Utilities Commission of Nevada (“Commission”) makes the following
findings of fact and conclusions of law:

I. INTRODUCTION

Nevada Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Nevada and AT&T Wholesale (“AT&T Nevada”) filed with the Commission an application, designated as Docket No. 24-05006 (“Application”), for approval of a change of name to Nevada Bell Telephone Company, LLC d/b/a AT&T Nevada and AT&T Wholesale for telecommunication service conducted under CPC 616 Sub 27.

II. SUMMARY

The Commission grants AT&T Nevada’s Application, subject to the satisfaction of the compliance item delineated in this Order.

III. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

- On May 3, 2024, AT&T Nevada filed the Application pursuant to the Nevada Revised Statutes (“NRS”) and the Nevada Administrative Code (“NAC”) Chapters 703 and 704, including but not limited to, NAC 704.7494.

- The Regulatory Operations Staff of the Commission (“Staff”) participates as a matter of right pursuant to NRS 703.301.
- On May 9, 2024, the Commission issued a Notice of Application for Change of Name for Competitive Telecommunications Company.
- On June 24, 2024, AT&T Nevada filed an errata to Exhibit A of the Application.
- On July 8, 2024, Staff filed a briefing memorandum (“Staff’s Briefing Memorandum”).
- On July 9, 2024, the Commission voted to adopt the recommendations contained in Staff’s Briefing Memorandum.

IV. APPLICATION

AT&T Nevada’s Request

1. AT&T Nevada seeks approval of a change of name to Nevada Bell Telephone Company, LLC d/b/a AT&T Nevada and AT&T Wholesale for telecommunication service conducted under CPC 616 Sub 27. (Application at 1.)

Staff’s Position

2. Staff states that AT&T Nevada’s Application, as amended, requires applicable certificates required by NAC 704.7472(1)(g)(1)¹ that reflect the new name of AT&T Nevada. (Staff’s Briefing Memorandum at 2.) Staff recommends that the Commission issue an order granting AT&T Nevada’s Application, cancelling CPC 616 Sub 27, and issuing CPC 616 Sub 28 to Nevada Bell Telephone Company, LLC d/b/a AT&T Nevada and AT&T Wholesale, authorizing it to operate as a competitive supplier of telecommunication service within the State of Nevada, contingent upon AT&T Nevada filing with the Commission, within ninety (90) days

¹ NAC 704.7472(1)(g)(1) reads: reads: “An application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity filed by a competitive supplier must contain all the following information, either in the application or as exhibits attached to it: if the competitive supplier is doing business or intends to do business in this State under an assumed or fictitious name: A copy of each certificate that the competitive supplier has filed or intends to file pursuant to chapter 602 of NRS with the county clerk of each county in which the competitive supplier is doing business or intends to do business.”

Commission Discussion and Findings

3. The Commission adopts the analysis and recommendations found in Staff's Briefing Memorandum. Accordingly, consistent with Staff's recommendations, the Commission finds that AT&T Nevada's Application has met the requirements of NAC 704.7494, and grants the Application as amended.

4. The Commission further finds that AT&T Nevada must file with the Commission, within ninety (90) days after the effective date of the order in this Docket, as compliance items, the following Certificates of Business Name Change from the following counties reflecting the new name of Nevada Bell Telephone Company, LLC d/b/a AT&T Nevada and AT&T Wholesale:

Therefore, it is ordered:

1. The Application of Nevada Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Nevada and AT&T Wholesale, designated as Docket No. 24-05006, is granted as amended, and as provided by and consistent with this Order.

Compliances

2. Prior to the issuance of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity 616 Sub 28, Nevada Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Nevada and AT&T Wholesale must file with the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada within ninety (90) days after the effective date of the order in this Docket, as compliance items, the following Certificates of Business Name Change from the following counties reflecting the new name of Nevada Bell Telephone Company, LLC d/b/a AT&T Nevada and AT&T Wholesale:

- a. Carson City County.

3. Upon the Regulatory Operations Staff of the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada's verification of the completion of the compliance items set forth above, the Assistant Commission Secretary of the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada shall cancel Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity 616 Sub 27, held by Nevada Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Nevada and AT&T Wholesale and issue Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity 616 Sub 28, to Nevada Bell Telephone Company, LLC d/b/a AT&T Nevada and AT&T Wholesale, authorizing it to operate as a competitive supplier of telecommunication service within the state of Nevada and as a provider of last resort for basic network service and business line service in its service area consistent with the final order in Docket No. 24-02034.
